

What is hemp?

AND ANY PART OF THAT PLANT, INCLUDING THE SEEDS THEREOF AND ALL DERIVATIVES, EXTRACTS, CANNABINOIDS, ISOMERS, ACIDS, SALTS, AND SALTS OF ISOMERS, WHETHER GROWING OR NOT, WITH A TOTAL DELTA-9 **TETRAHYDROCANNABINOL** CONCENTRATION OF NOT MORE THAN 0.3 PERCENT ON A DRY WEIGHT BASIS."

Collaboration with NRCS and over 50 partners to help producers and landowners adopt Climate-Smart practices

We are pioneering the use of industrial hemp to significantly reduce sediment by up to 50% & nitrates by 20% each year

Our aim is to improve water quality in the Mississippi River Basin Critical Conservation Area, including the 926 sq. mile Lake Decatur watershed







<u>Asset Based</u>- Focuses on the Community Assets, Skills, and Resources Available. Solutions come from with in!




