


Who are we?

- Regional programs to reduce energy & greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions

Program Goals

- Bring energy efficiency to small, medium & hard-to-reach businesseses
- Create bill savings for local businesses
- Reduce GHG emissions

Budget Breakdown

Hard-to-Reach

- \$1,096,076 for the 2024 Program Year
- 2x incentive multiplier
- Must meet HTR & Small Business requirements

Market Rate


- \$300,000 for the 2024 Program Year
- No incentive multipliers
- Still must meet Small Business requirements

The 3C-REN Commercial Energy Savings Program is funded through 2027

How it works

- 1. Sign Up
 - a. Complete Flexibility Purchase Agreement (FPA) & Terms and Conditions
- 2. Recruit Customers
 - a. Check eligibility against tools provided
- 3. Submit proposed project for Reservation (Project Hub)
- 4. Install the project and submit the final paperwork to commence savings tracking
- 5. Get Paid
 - a. Upfront payments and Quarterly Performance Payments

How You Get Paid



- Quarterly payments directly to the contractor based on the actual portfolio savings as measured at the meter over 12 months
- 20% Advanced Payments, made monthly
- All Hard-to-Reach Projects have a 2.0x multiplier applied after the base incentive is computed, utilized the avoided cost benefits



Customer & Project Eligibility

•	Must be located in either San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, or Ventura Counties
•	Must receive electric distribution and natural gas services from any combination of PG&E, SCE, and SoCalGas.
	Must have annual energy usage less than 150,000 kWh, and less than 50,000 therms
•	Must be associated with an eligible NAICS code

Hard-to-Reach Eligibility

San Luis Obispo County & Santa Barbara County

At least one of the following:

- Language- Primary language spoken is other than English
- Business Size 25 or fewer employees and/or classified as Very Small (Customers whose annual electric demand is less than 20 kilowatts (kW), or whose annual gas consumption is less than 10,000 therm, or both), and/or
- Leased or Rented Facilities Investments in improvements to a facility rented or leased by a participating business customer.
- Municipal Building(s)
- Member of a California Native American Tribe



Hard-to-Reach Eligibility

Ventura County

Located in a DAC and at least one of the following criteria:

- Language- Primary language spoken is other than English
- Business Size 25 or fewer employees and/or classified as Very Small (Customers whose annual electric demand is less than 20 kilowatts (kW), or whose annual gas consumption is less than 10,000 therm, or both), and/or
- Leased or Rented Facilities Investments in improvements to a facility rented or leased by a participating business customer.

OR


Not located in a DAC and meet all three criteria:


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- Business Size 25 or fewer employees and/or classified as Very Small (Customers whose annual electric demand is less than 20 kilowatts (kW), or whose annual gas consumption is less than 10,000 therm, or both), and/or
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

- Municipal Building(s)
- Member of a California Native American Tribe
